Celebration is an American Cancer Society grassroots event celebrating cancer survivorship and empowering survivors and others to advocate for laws that will help fight cancer. Thousands of people from across the nation will come together in Washington, D.C. to share their personal stories and educate our elected officials about the cancer-related needs of patients, families and all Americans. And the Mall in Washington will be transformed into one giant Relay For Life event, with tents representing each state and thousands of luminaries outlining the reflecting pool.

What is a Celebration on the Hill Ambassador?

Celebration on the Hill Ambassadors will be cancer survivors, caregivers, health professionals, researchers and local volunteers who represent the diversity of their Congressional district. Ambassadors will carry an urgent, unified message to lawmakers—I Care About Cancer And I Vote.

Eight Celebration Ambassadors per Congressional district will be chosen through a competitive process. Ambassadors who are selected will serve as leaders, working with advocacy staff to engage in federal, state and community advocacy

activities, and will represent the American Cancer Society at Celebration on the Hill 2006.
